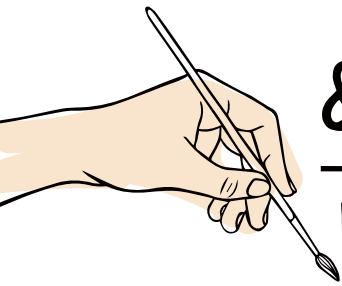

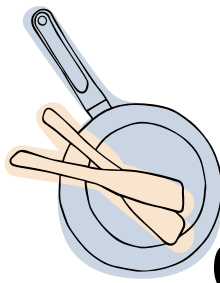
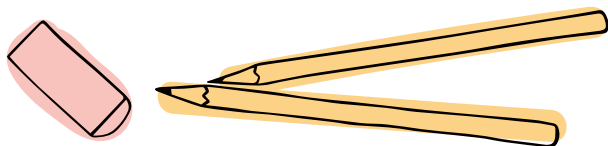

## Chef in Training

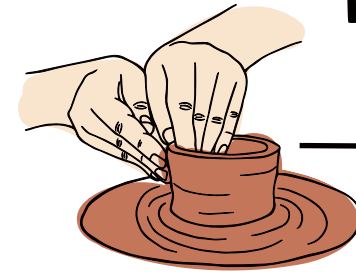
CHRISTINA RHODES

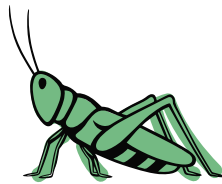


## Play with Clay
