Ceramics CRYSTALLINE GLAZES WITH ZACH MOORE

This class is for all skill levels. Students will be guided through the process of throwing both basic and elegant forms, learning basic glaze chemistry, and be introduced to the entrancing world of crystalline glazes. Each individual will have the opportunity to discuss and make their own crystalline vessels throughout the duration of the class. Students will learn a multitude of techniques and will be encouraged to add their own style and make pieces their own.



Drawing & Painting WITH CORAH LOROW

For all skill levels. This course will cover various drawing and painting techniques through group and individual projects, taking on new techniques, topics, and concepts each week. With assistance from the instructor, students will develop and hone their skills while exploring new processes and ideas.



Cooking

WITH ZACH SHAW

Over this eight week course students will learn the fundamental building blocks of cooking and will go over basic sauce recipes, meat preparation, and working with vegetables. Students will leave the class with essential cooking skills they can use to continue their education in bigger kitchens and recipes. Those who take the class will learn the ABC's of cooking and there will be no challenge they can't overcome.



Ukulele

This class will cover the basic foundations for learning to play the ukulele and provide an introduction to music theory. The instructor will focus on each student individually, allowing for mastery of technique and precision at their own pace. The class will cover chords, scales, songs, and learning how to continue to refine musical skills at home. Students can bring their own ukulele, or instruments will be provided with a deposit of \$60. At the end of the eight week course, students can purchase their ukuleles or return the instrument for a full refund.
